Over the week it would be lovely for the children to try some of the following activities. Do as many as the activities as possible but not all together space them out throughout the week. You could repeat some of the activities throughout the week just 5 minutes on each

Phonics

Play Bertha goes to the zoo. Set up a toy zoo and join the children in their play and add an animal name to the list with the same sound. Use the animals and chant the rhyme- Bertha the bus is going to the zoo, who does she see as she passes through? A pig, a parrot, a polar bear and a panda!

Continue with other sounds and animals.
