What to do if your child or member of your household tests positive over the Christmas period

For the first 6 days after the end of term (Friday 18th December), school has been asked to work these days and support the Track and Trace system. Both myself and Mrs Robson (Head

Teacher of the Junior school) will work up to, and including Christmas Eve, responding to parent emails informing us of positive COVID test results. If your child tests **positive** for coronavirus (Covid-19), then parents are requested to contact the school immediately via the school email address **enquiries@bsi.school**.

<u>Please mark the subject box as **POSITIVE COVID TEST** give your child's name, date symptoms started and date positive test result was received.</u>

The school will then identify any children that have been in close contact in school to the affected person in the last 48 hours from the onset of their symptoms. The parents of these children will be contacted and advised that their child needs to self- isolate for 14 days from their last contact with the positive case.

The emails will be checked each morning before 10.00am and parents notified immediately afterwards.

After the 24th December, we will not contact you asking your child to self- isolate due to close contact at school. However, should your child or a family member test positive after this date, you still need to inform school via email so that we can advise you of your child's return date in January following the appropriate length of self- isolation.

The children can come to school in non- uniform or party clothes to avoid having to get changed part way through the day.
