FS 1 Happy Home Learning

We have been practising writing our names in class this week and looking at the handwrite rhymes to support us so you will be able to show your grown up's your amazing work.

FS2 Homework

This week we are looking at contractions. Please look carefully for the missing letters and remember to replace these with an apostrophe.

What other contractions do you know? The spell check will contain some 'mystery spellings'. These will be different contractions to the above.

Reading- Read your colour-banded book every day to develop word-reading and comprehension. It is important for your child to read it again and again to improve their fluency and speed. Please record all reads in the home-school diary. Diaries will be checked every Monday.

Y1 Maths – This week the children have been learning all the number bonds to 8 and also how to use the + and = symbol to make simple number sentences. Using 8 1p coins or 8 buttons or raisins for example – ask your child to split the whole amount of 8 raisins into two parts and write the matching number sentence, such as $2 + 6 = 8$. Ask them to tell you what the two parts are and what is the whole amount. There are 9 number bonds. Can they find them all?

Y2 Maths- We continue to work on place value. Play the topmarks basketball place value game
