## Food Tasting Thursday – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2023



Our school dinners are very popular and provide the children with a healthy and nutritional meal. A school meal is provided **free** of charge to all our FS2, YR1 and YR2 children. Parents only need to pay for school meals once the children start the Junior school.

On Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January, children who normally bring a packed lunch will also have the opportunity to try a school dinner. You can still provide a packed lunch from home as well if you so wish. The dinner choice on this day will be:

**Red choice** – Roast Chicken, Yorkshire pudding with potatoes and vegetables.

**Yellow choice** – Quorn Burger.

Both above options are followed by a hot or cold pudding - Iced Sponge & custard or cookie.

**Green choice** – a freshly prepared sandwich with Cheese or Tuna filling.

Fresh fruit and salad bar also available

There is a varied menu operating on a 3 weekly cycle and are cooked freshly on the premises. All meals conform to strict food standards which ensure they are healthy and nutritious. Our past experience of these 'taster days' have shown that the children really do enjoy their school meal. In addition, many children went on to choose a school meal option every day, and parents were thrilled with the savings they made in terms of the time and money it took to provide a daily packed lunch.

## Social Media App 'Frog'

South Yorkshire Police and Social Care have received concerning information regarding a new **social media App called 'Frog'**. The App is aimed at a Primary aged audience and has recently exploded in popularity. Police have significant concerns as the App is primarily targeted at primary aged children. The App has very limited identity verification requirements.

Specialist Police partners have seen significant information suggesting there is a legitimate risk to Primary aged children being groomed.

Can you choose combinations of different coins this week to count. Put them in order of their value to make it easier to find totals.
