Class 8 will be visiting the library for their reading treat on Monday 2nd July. The scores were very close this time with Class 7 closely coming 2nd and Class 6 coming 3rd. We will still be checking children's diaries weekly to see how often they are reading at home. Scores have been much lower this term with the average score never reaching above 3 reads a week. We strongly recommend that you share a book with your child **every day**, even if it's just for 10 minutes. The positive impact this has on your child's learning is huge! Well done to the Super Readers in every class. We hope you are enjoying your Super Reader treats!

Free School Meals Information - £25 Uniform Voucher

As you are aware, all children in FS2, Year 1 & 2 are entitled to receive a Universal Free School Meal which is funded by the government. However, many families do not realise that they may qualify for benefits related free school meals (pupil premium). **If parents apply and are eligible, your child can access FREE educational visits, FREE After School Clubs along with many other activities which take place in school throughout the year and normally involve payment.** If you apply and are granted this benefit, you will also receive a **£25 voucher** issued by the school office to spend at one of our local uniform suppliers; Ella Bella's in Bramley.
