### World Book Day

**'Book in a Box':** It's time to get creative and bring a book to life! Choose your favourite book and make the setting and characters inside a box (shoe box/cereal box). Decorate your box inside and out to represent the different parts of the book.

Here are some tips/ideas:

- Draw or cut out pictures of the characters or significant objects from the book.
- Recreate a scene from the book inside.
- Include interesting quotes from the text.
- Don't forget to include the title and author of the book too.
  
- Make it as colourful and exciting as you can.

Label your box clearly with your name and class and bring your 'book in a box' into school by Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March.
