### **Class 6,7 & 10 Homework**

#### **Reading**

Continue to read at home. Let's see if you can contribute a 6 or 7 to your class Reading Race score! Please ensure you are reading your zippy wallet book as well as your colour-banded book. We have rewards for the most improved class so see if you can up your score if your class hasn't won yet!

#### **Spellings**

**Y1-** do don't does didn't see tree green meet what other words do you know with 'What can you see' ee  
**Y2 class 6-** Check your child can spell the above words. Then try..... dancing riding having saving making joking What other words do you know where you 'drop the e and add -ing'?

## Maths

**Y1-** This week the children have been learning that if we add 2 to an even number, it will give us the next even number and that if we add 2 to an odd number it will give us the next odd number and similarly if we subtract 2 it will give us the next odd or even number. Play a Quick Fire Round to check your child's fluency in the concept. For example: Choose an even number. "6". What is the next odd number? What is the previous odd number? Repeat with odd numbers. Check that your child can identify all the odd and even numbers to 10.

**Y2-** This week we have been grouping whole amounts in different ways using equipment. We described our grouping in words and in a number sentence

e.g    **Grouping 4**            00  00            2 groups of 2            2 X 2  
  0000            1 group of 4            1 X 4  
  0  0  0  0            4 groups of 1            4

Please don't use 'times' when children are writing the number sentence We initially teach it as 'groups of'
