Phonics Screen Check breakfast and lunchtime booster clubs continue this half term and leading up to the Phonics Screen Check week from Monday 9th June – Friday 13th June. Thank you for your commitment to this. We strongly urge you to not book a holiday during this period or incur any unnecessary absence. This could result in your child being required to re-sit the check the following year in Y2 2026.

Please note that <u>ALL</u> term-time holidays are classed as unauthorised.

Please also be reminded that any <u>late arrival</u> (*after registers have closed*) is recorded as an 'Unauthorised Absence' so please make every effort to arrive at school before the registers are closed at **9:15am.**

Thank you to all parents and carers that are supporting good attendance of 90%+

If your child has less than 90% attendance it is categorised as 'persistence absence' at 50% is categorised as 'severe absence'. You will be sent a letter to alert you and to offer support. If your

child's attendance declines further, you will be invited into school for a meeting to discuss how support might improve your child's attendance. If this continues the Local Authority will issue with an official 'Notice to Improve' and proceed with the Rotherham SAMP process. You can view your current attendance on Arbor.

Congratulations to the seventy three children across school who received 100% attendance certificates last term and also to three of our children for achieving the most improved attendance medals.

Reporting Illnesses

When deciding if your child is well enough for school, please consult the NHS link: https://www.nhs.uk/live-well/is-my-child-too-ill-for-school/. Thank you for communicating any absence, appointments and late arrivals via the school office. This is much appreciated. Please be reminded that we need a reason for any absence for our records. We notice that we have allocated a high number of medical appointments during the school day and ask you, where at all possible to take these out of school hours or in the school holidays.

School Uniform

Please can we remind you about school uniform and jewellery from a safety perspective. We ask that you ensure children are in suitable footwear for school and wear only stud earring – no other jewellery. Children who come to school wearing inappropriate items will be asked to put them in their school bag. We have lots of spare school uniform at the front of school should you need it. Please help yourselves. FS1/Nursery Admissions

We have allocated our new FS1/Nursery school children places for September 2025 and transition has begun. Y2/Y3 Junior School transition

Transition planning has begun between our Infant school and the Junior school. We will refine this and communicate this in due course. A comprehensive transition schedule is being compiled for July. We know and understand that for many children and families' thoughts and feelings are already building around transition. We will be including some themes into our curriculum, storytime and discussions to positively prepare.

Breakfast Club £4

07:45-08:30am Now available to book on Arbor up until Summer! Please note that places are available to book as a **block booking payment**. **F2-Y2** (under consultation)

During this session children can enjoy a varied choice of breakfast food and drink. Daily cost includes a choice of food and drinks. During this special time before school children enjoy games, crafts and sports with their friends and are well supported by our happy, caring adults.



We are pleased to be able to move forward with our wraparound care offer which will be implemented in stages during the forthcoming months. The wraparound offer criteria is not available to FS1 children from September. We are able to offer a breakfast club initially to a raised number of 30 pupils (F2-Y2) from 7:45-8:30am with a block extended booking. We aim to make the breakfast club available from 7:30am in due course,

available for block whole year booking. This is in support of the Government agenda for working families.



Think 'Pharmacy First'




