Since January 2022, an increase in the number of acute (sudden onset) hepatitis cases in the UK in children aged 10 and under has been detected. Y1 Maths This week we have been counting large amounts of objects by grouping them into tens and ones. You could use lego bricks, pasta pieces or anything you have a large amount of! Grab a handful and see how many tens you can make. E.g How many tens do you have? **I have 3 tens** How many ones do you have? **I have 4 ones** Now let's count **Ten ,twenty, thirty. Thirty one , thirty two, thirty three ,thirty four.**

Y2 Maths This week we have been partitioning two digit numbers in different ways. Choose a two digit number and draw/write different ways to partition it. E.g **46** $46 = 40 + 6$ $46 = 30 + 16$ $46 = 20 + 26$
 $46 = 10 + 36$ $46 = 0 + 46$ (Can you see a pattern?)


