Phonics

In preparation for the Year 1 Phonics Screening check, please read the list of real and alien words that have been sent home with your child. Remember you can sound out each word – just remember to blend it at the end by saying the full word. E.g. **s c r ea m scream**

Continue to practise any sounds that your child is not confident with. Use the sounds at the front of the home-school diary to support you with this.

Maths

Double numbers up to 10. E.g. $6+6=12$

Year 2 Homework

Spellings

great break steak water climb money parents anything something nothing

Practise each word by writing it 3 times using the look, cover, write, check strategy.

You will know you can spell each word when you can write it correctly in a sentence.

Maths

Practise counting amounts of money. Ask your grownup if you can look in their purse/wallet with them.

Choose 4 notes/coins. Find the total. Remember to arrange the coins in order of their value to make it easier to count them. You could draw the money and write the total or record it as a number sentence. Write the total.

Challenge- Make the **same amount of money** using **4 different combinations of coins**

e.g. $52p = 50p + 2p$ $52p = 50p + 1p + 1p$ $52p = 20p + 20p + 10p + 2p$

$52p = 20p + 10p + 10p + 10p + 1p + 1p$

Leave of Absence Requests including Term Time Holidays

There has been an increase in requests for special leave of absence in term time in recent weeks. We would like to remind you that absence taken during term time, and in particular, for the purpose of holidays, will not be authorised and could result in a fine being issued by the Local Authority. Only where there are extenuating circumstances for the request which are accompanied by written evidence will Fixed Penalty Notices **not** be referred. In all cases, the absence will not be authorised.

Absence

It has come to our attention that there have been an increasing number of instances in which school has been contacted reporting a child's illness when in fact special leave is being taken. On more than one occasion we have found that children have been asked to keep this a secret but invariably children like to share happy memories with the staff and their friends in the classroom. Please can I ask that you are honest with regard to any special leave and family days out. We cannot authorise any holidays without exceptional circumstances. It is vitally important that there is honesty and respect between home and school and that children are not put in a difficult position with trusted adults and their friends. Thank you for your support in this matter.
