#### **Yorkshire & Humber UKHSA Health Protection**

We have been given the following information by Yorkshire & Humber UKHSA Health Protection regarding scarlet fever AND chickenpox.

Both chickenpox and scarlet fever are considered to be common infections, mild and of low public health risk. It is usual to see an increase in scarlet fever and chickenpox notifications this time of year. However, over the two years of the COVID-19 pandemic response, there was a significant reduction in notifications of many other infections. As there was little chickenpox activity during this period, we are likely to see a rise in reported cases of chickenpox and scarlet fever.
