Please note this activity is entirely voluntary and children's attendance is at the discretion of the parent/carer.



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School Attendance Level

As you are aware, our schools expected level of attendance this year is 96%. We have worked hard to make sure that we succeed in meeting our target this year. With your support, we have so far managed to maintain a level above 96%. Whilst we acknowledge that genuine illness cannot be avoided and children need to be off school, we have had an increase in families requesting leave in term time for the purpose of holidays. We therefore urge you to continue to work with us in supporting regular school attendance and punctuality to keep this level above 96%. The attendance data we submit to the authority is collected right up to the last day of term (Friday 19th July). We thank you for your continued support and look forward to reporting good news in September when we receive the official attendance figures.

We would remind you that term time holidays will **not** be authorised and will be marked on your child's record as an unauthorised absence, the Local Authority will be informed and if it meets the criteria, the Local Authority will then issue a Fixed Penalty Notice.

When your child is absent from school, please remember to call the school office before 9.30am on each day of the absence. In order to comply with safeguarding procedures, we will contact you if we do not receive a message.
