Sun Safety Information

A Heat Wave is currently predicted for next week with temperatures predicted to reach 26 degrees Celsius.

As a school we will put the following actions in place...

- Cleaning team to open all windows before school to allow residual heat to escape
- Window Blinds to be closed wherever possible
- Electrical equipment and lights to be turned off whenever possible
- Other teaching spaces to be used in school if temperatures are cooler
- Time outside to be carefully monitored and reduced where necessary
- Children's water intake to be supervised by staff at regular points of the day (please ensure your child has a water bottle in school)
- Staff to remind children to apply sunscreen before going out for their lunch break (please ensure you apply your child's sunscreen in the morning before coming to school)
- Staff to remind children to wear sun hats before going outside (Please ensure they are all labelled)

During this spell of particularly warm weather, please make sure that you provide a sun hat for your child to wear when outdoors. Sun cream labelled with your child's name, can be brought to school but can only be applied by your child. We would therefore ask you to apply your child's sun screen each morning before they come to school. Thank you.



It is advised that all children wear a sun hat and have sun glasses for school and have a water bottle with them. We will take regular water-breaks to ensure that the children remain hydrated. Please ensure your child has their water bottle. You may want to send your child with a water bottle with chilled water (or even from the freezer) to start the day. Water will be available in school and children will have access to their water bottles throughout the day and we will ensure that children are reminded to drink water regularly throughout the day

Please ensure that your child's cardigans and jumpers are clearly labelled as they are frequently discarded on the playground when the children get warm whilst playing. We try our best to make sure that the children take home their own clothing but mix ups happen and it is difficult to re-unite clothing if it is not labelled.



We understand the importance of keeping track of your child's belongings especially clothing items. To assist with this, we have fabric pens available in the classroom for parents to use. These pens are specifically designed for marking clothing and other fabric items.

We ask that children come to school in their usual shoes and not flip flops, sliders or crocs.

Scooters/bikes and other ride on toys

For the safety of all our children, we respectfully ask that you do not allow your child to ride bikes, scooters or any other ride-on toys in the area directly in front of the staff car park entrances. There are blind spots for drivers that are driving in and out of the car parks. Please ask your child to walk their bike/scooter while crossing a vehicle entrance. Thank you for your co-operation.
