Don't forget to include different question openers such as when, where, how etc and remember your question mark at the end.

**Maths**

We are working hard on trying to mentally work out calculations. Choose any two-digit number and add it to another two-digit number. Try and use your known facts to help you work them out at speed.

e.g.  $52 + 37 = 89$  I know  $5 + 3 = 8$  and I know  $2 + 7 = 9$  therefore the answer is 89.

See if you can do about 10 calculations independently on your own.
