A message from the Governors

Hi everyone,

I am the parent governor for wellbeing in school for staff and children. During my visit this term on school governors' week I looked at:

1. Children who have Social Emotional and Mental Health Needs and how school support children. I found that school are meeting the needs of children with Social emotional and Mental Health Needs. I have observed staff to be caring, calm and empathetic in their interactions with children. School liaise with specialist provisions to seek further guidance and recommendations for children with additional needs. At lunch time school also support with quieter provision for children who find the big yard overwhelming.
2. I also observed lunch time provision; the children were well mannered, polite and encouraged to choose healthy meals and snacks. They sat together in their friendship groups and talked amongst friends. Outside some of the children played on the yard games that were drawn on and often came up and asked me who I was.
3. I then visited the children in Class 8 who told me they liked school; they felt safe and enjoyed it. They knew the school values and told me they post a bead in when they have shown one of the values to their teachers. The schools' council board members were on display with their book should the children wish to raise a concern or worry and how they would do this with the school council.
4. School staff are also supporting each other with their own wellbeing as it can be very demanding job for staff and they work so hard. They have developed a staff newsletter for wellbeing ideas for themselves and are supporting each other as a school family. It is so important we all look after each other and support everyone's wellbeing.
