### **FS 1 Happy Home Learning**

**Personal Social & Emotional Development:** Can you help your grown up's with the laundry at home? Can you pair all the socks? Are there any odd ones?

**Physical Development:** Continue to practice putting on your own coat and shoes independently

**Communication & Language Development:** Read at least 3 times a week with your grown up's and record it in your home-school diary. This week we have been singing the rhyme Little lion. Can you practice at home – "1 little lion, learning how to roar, (pretend to roar once) Along came another one that's one more. Two little lions learning how to roar (pretend to roar twice) Along came another one that's one more. Three little lions learning how to roar (pretend to roar three times) That's enough little lions we don't need any more!"

### **FS2 Homework**

#### **Literacy**

Watch the following clip of the story we have been reading this week – Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YwCU6Tg3xFU> Can you draw a picture of your favourite fruit and try to think of the first sound of its name. Talk about why it is your favourite fruit with your grown up. They can write what you said in your homework learning if you like.

#### **Maths**

Find some items in your home to make a pattern with. These could be socks, cars, counters, buttons... Make them into a pattern and talk about what you have done. It could be a shape pattern, a picture or a repeating pattern. See what patterns you can make.



### **Class 6, 9 and 10 Homework**

#### **Reading**

Read your colour-banded book every day to develop word-reading and comprehension. Please read the green words, red words and vocabulary check before the story. It is important for your child to read the text many times to help improve their fluency. Please record all reads in the home-school diary.

**Y1**-said some come or will no


**Y2** - race ice city face fancy - Which other words have the soft 'c' sound?

#### **Maths**

**Y1**-This week the children have been splitting a whole amount of objects into two parts. Using different examples ask your child to split any amount (up to 10) into two parts. (The parts do not have to be equal)

For example – Split an amount of raisins between them and a family member/split a whole amount of toy figures into two teams for a sports day/split a whole amount of biscuits on to two plates etc. Each time say the sentence for example: 5 is the whole – 3 is a part and 2 is a part.

$$3 + 7 + 4 =$$

$$8 + 3 + 2 =$$

$$4 + 5 + 5 =$$

$$9 + 6 + 1 =$$

$$5 + 9 + 1 =$$
