Happy Home Learning

Foundation Stage 2

Literacy - In literacy this week we have been watching some clips from the Little Mermaid film. Write a sentence about what happened in the film. Remember to be an independent writer by saying the word you want to write yourself, listening to the sounds you hear and writing them down.

Number - In number work this week we have been learning to recognise, order and write numbers from 0 to 20. Can you make your own number line to 20 and use the number line to practise 1 more/1 less.

Year 1

Reading - Please read your reading books.

Spellings - make made take came same safe play day stay say way

Extra challenge - Can you write any other words that have these phonemes. 'may I play ay' 'make a cake a-e'

Maths - Can you practise adding two single digit numbers. E.g $6 + 7 = 13$. Can you practise adding a two digit number to a single digit number e.g $14 + 5 = 19$

Extra challenge - Choose a number up to 20 e.g 15. Now find all the addition bonds that make that number. e.g $15 + 0$, $14 + 1$, $13 + 2$ etc.

Topic - Think about the different families of living things

e.g humans, plants, animals, insects, birds, etc. Can you draw or find some pictures of animals that belong to these families?

Year 2

Spellings: London, great, fire, spread, Pudding Lane and bakery

Literacy:

In literacy we will be studying the Great Fire of London 1666. Can you research where the fire started, how it started and how they managed to put it out? Also can you find any interesting facts about this event in history that you can share with the class?

Maths:

Instead of setting maths homework this week, we would like you to challenge yourself and your grown-up to get fitter. Can you set up your own circuit stations and get fitter with your grown ups.

For example: 20 start jumps/jogging on the spot for 2 minutes/speed bounce/ 20 tuck jumps/ 30 step ups/10 sit ups/5 press ups.

Head Lice
