FS2 Homework

In literacy this week, Barnaby Bear has been to France. He especially enjoyed his time in Disneyland Paris. Please ask the children to draw their favourite Disney character and write a simple sentence about them that they can then read to their friends.

In maths, we have been thinking about one more and language associated with this. Please encourage your child to use different vocabulary when talking about groups of objects. We have also been singing one more rhymes (eg one elephant went out to play) which you can find on YouTube kids. Please sing and then play one more games with objects around the house eg small toys, counters, buttons, smarties etc.

Year 1 Homework

Literacy

Please read your reading book. How did the characters feel at different points in the story and why? If you are reading a non-fiction text can you spot features such as... titles, contents, captions, labels

Year 1 Maths

We have been learning about '**whole**' and '**not whole**'. Look at some fruit/veg/food. Is it a '**whole**' one? This means we have '**all of it**'. (Remember you can cut something but still have all of it. So don't let your child get confused and think because I have cut it it's not a whole.) Use this precise language.... **If we have all of it, it's still a whole.**

If you have a '**part**' of something e.g some of it is **not there/missing** then this is '**not whole**'.

You could give your child some 'whole' objects and some 'parts/not whole' to sort . Can they explain why it is 'whole' or 'not whole'?

Year 2 Homework

Topic / Literacy -This week we are going to be baking biscuits as part of our science learning. Can you research a basic biscuit recipe and have a go at baking them? After take a photograph and write down ingredients you used and the method.

Maths - This week we will be learning how to divide a whole amount into equal parts. Using sweets or raisins practise counting out a whole amount and sharing it equally into 2/5/10 parts. Take a photograph of how you have shared your sweets or raisins.
Spellings - want, watch, wander, squash, quantity
What other words are pronounced with an 'o' sound but are spelt with an 'a'?
