## FS2 Homework

### Maths

We have been singing lots of different number rhymes. Please sing '1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a Fish Alive' with your child. Count carefully in lots of different ways to 5. This could include counting claps, hops, jumps and objects around the home.

### Literacy

We have been singing lots of nursery rhymes and emphasising the rhyming words. Please sing rhymes eg Humpty Dumpty and change some of the words eg Humpty Dumpty sat on a log, Humpty Dumpty fell on a frog.

## Y1 Homework

### Maths

We have been looking at ways of making numbers within 10. We have done this practically with counters and used drawings as well. We have used the 'part, part, whole' method.

E.g. Making 5:

The whole amount is 5. One part is 1 and one part is 4.

The whole amount is 5. One part 2 and one part is 3.

The whole amount is 5. One part is 0 and one part is 5.

How many ways can you make 6? How many ways can you make 7? Remember to speak in full sentences.

### Literacy

We have read the story of The Smartest Giant in Town by Julia Donaldson. You could share this story on youtube if you don't have the book. Can you plan a new outfit for George the giant? Draw and label his clothing using adjectives and nouns to describe each item. E.g. a green hat, a spotty tie
