### Reminder - Parent Walkabout – Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July 3pm-5pm

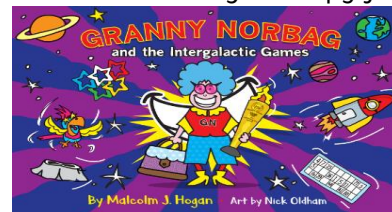
This is an opportunity to say a fond farewell to your child's current teacher and then visit their new classroom and say 'Hello' to their new teacher.

### FS2 Homework

#### Literacy

This week the children have visited their new teacher and classroom. In your homework book write a simple sentence about your new teacher or classroom.

#### Maths

In maths this week we have been learning the 3D shape names, sphere, cuboid, cube, cylinder and cone. See if you can find some of these shapes around your house or outside. Eg. A tin of beans – cylinder, ice-cream - cone , die - cube

#### Literacy

Practise the spelling rule for plurals.

Usually just add **s** if there is more than one of something.

If the noun ends in the **s/ss/ch/sh/x** sound, add **es**.

Change the following singular nouns to plurals:

box shoe hat fox bush mug paint match cake bus dress pear

#### Maths

Practise finding a quarter of amounts. E.g. pizza, cake, sandwich.

Can you make 2 quarters? What do you notice?

Can you make 3 quarters?

Practise these words by writing each one three times and by writing them in sentences.

#### Maths





Investigate what happens when you add 2 odd numbers? (Is your total odd or even?)

What happens when you add 3 odd numbers? What happens if you add 2 even numbers?

What happens if you add 3 even numbers? What about a mixture of odd and even?

Can you formulate a set of rules? e.g. When I add 2 odd numbers the answer is always/sometimes/never odd. Have fun investigating!
