There will be **NO** tennis club before school next Friday 19th July.

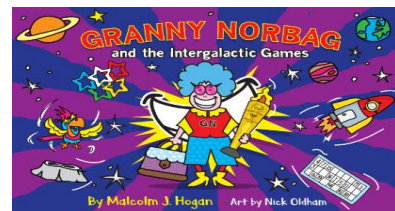
### Breakfast Club from September 2019
