In your homework book make a snake number line to 10. Concentrate on the correct number formation which can be found in your home/school diary. Use your number line to ask mathematical questions. Eg. What number comes before 3? What is one more than 3? What is one less than 5? Use equipment alongside to show the amount increasing by 1 or decreasing by 1.
