Over the week it would be lovely for the children to try some of the following activities. Do as many as the activities as possible but not all together space them out throughout the week. Lots of activities can be repeated over the week to consolidate the children's learning.

Happy Learning.

Phonics

Use the Espresso website. Go to the Foundation page then click on the literacy and then phonics icons.

Play the phase 2/3 phonics activities.

Literacy

Write a letter on love heart shaped paper to a member of your family telling them how much you love them.

Remember how to spell the tricky words and use your home school diary to remind you how we form the letters correctly.

Creative

Make a house using coloured paper, glue and scissors. Think about the shapes you might need.

Put a photo of your family in the house or draw pictures of your family and stick in.



Physical- Fine/Gross Motor Skills

Make an outdoor obstacle course. Use plastic plant pots to run around, a plank of wood to balance on and use string/rope as hurdles to jump over.

Race against the time, how quick can you complete the course?

Shared Reading

Read a story to your favourite teddy. Remember to use your magic reading finger/stick to follow the words.

Do a book review with your teddy. Tell your teddy what you liked about the beginning, middle and end of the story and why?

You could make your own book.

Number of the Week

Number 12

Count forwards and backwards to 12. Show an understanding of the meaning of 12. Can you stamp your feet 12 times? Can you touch your nose 12 times? Count 12 sweets and put them in a line. Count 12 counters or 1p coins from a pile. What is one more / one less than 12? Can we form the number 12? Can we add amounts together in different ways to make 12? Can we partition 12 into 2 groups using the counters or pennies? Remember when talking about 12 we don't say 1 and 2, we say "12 - 1 ten and 2 two ones"._Numberblocks 12 -
