Week Commencing 4th May 2020

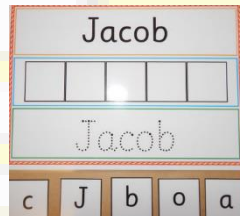
Over the week it would be lovely for the children to try some of the following activities. Do as many as the activities as possible but not all together space them out throughout the week. You could repeat some of the activities throughout the week just 5 minutes on each

Phonics

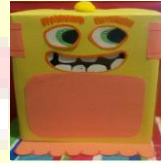
Make a sound bag. Make collections of objects that all begin with the same sound s e.g snake, sock, sausage, scissors, shirt, straw, skateboard, sunglasses, skittles, swimming costume, spider, spoon, soap. Create a song such as "What have we got in our sound bag today?" show an object one at a time and take it in turns to take something from the bag. Emphasise the initial sound sssssock, ssssausage, ssssunglasses.

Mark Making

Practice writing your name using your name card. Can you write it and then cut it up and make it into a jigsaw?

Creative

The children love sock monster at school! Using a box make a monster with a mouth. Then feed your monster smelly socks! Just like we do at school.

- 1, make a monster
- 2, roll a dice
- 3, feed the monster the correct amount of smelly socks.
