#### Sun Safety Information



During this spell of particularly hot weather, please make sure that you provide a sun hat for your child to wear when outdoors. Sun cream labelled with your child's name, can be brought to school but can only be applied by your child. We would therefore ask you to apply your child's sun screen each morning before they come to school.

Please ensure that your child's cardigans and jumpers are clearly labelled as they are frequently discarded on the playground when the children get warm whilst playing. We try our best to make sure that the children take home their own clothing but mix ups happen when clothing isn't labelled.

### **FS 1 Happy Home Learning**

**Reading:** Please read with your child 3 times a week or more, record your reading in your child's home/school diary.

**Phonics:** Emma the explorer has a list of things she needs to take on her next adventure but she can't read it! Can you help Emma work out what she needs to pack in her bag? Look at the words below and ask your grown up to say the sounds in the words and blend the sounds together to find out what she needs to take. Can you draw pictures of what she needs to take?

m-a-p, c-u-p, h-a-t, p-e-n.

**Mathematics:** Can you draw some animal patterns? Try black and white stripes like a zebra, orange and black stripes for a tiger.

Please share photographs of your home learning on our class dojo in your child's portfolio area.

### **FS2 Homework**

Literacy - practise reading and spelling the red words - was, are, once, do.  
You could write them in sentences too, e.g. It was fun at the park.

Maths - Make up some addition stories with your teddies. E.g **first** I had 2 teddies, **then** I got 3 more, **now** I have 5. Remember to use **first, then, now** to tell your stories.

Practise writing numbers 1 to 10. Form them correctly and the right way around.
