Parent Consultations (Week Commencing: 1st November 2021)

We are looking forward to being able to meet with Parents and Carers face to face to discuss how your child has settled into the new academic year and how together, we can support their learning both in school and at home.

Following the communication we sent to you all this week from Ben Anderson, Director of Public Health, Rotherham we are pleased to be able to currently focus on face to face learning. However, we are well aware that COVID-19 cases are extremely high in Rotherham, and the everyday steps that we can all take to reduce the spread of the virus are still vitally important.

With this in mind, in order to ensure that Face to Face Parent Consultation meetings are conducted as safely as possible staff will...

- Ensure the classroom is well ventilated
- Wear a face mask or shield during the consultation (unless exempt)
- Hand wash / sanitise regularly
- Maintain social distancing from Parents / Carers
- Keep to appointment times to help the flow of adults in school
- Continue to be encouraged to undertake twice weekly covid testing before coming to school

We would respectfully ask all adults attending appointments to ...

- Arrive at school at the appointment time
- Wear a face covering (unless medically exempt)
- Maintain a social distance from other adults
- Leave the site promptly at the end of the appointment to allow other Parents / Carers to attend

Please **DO NOT ATTEND** Parent consultation appointments if you have any **symptoms of COVID-19** and inform the school office so that a telephone appointment can be arranged.
