Keep reading your school texts little and often. Remember we aim for seven reads a week – even if it's just for five minutes!

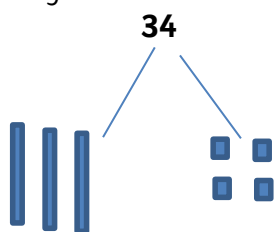

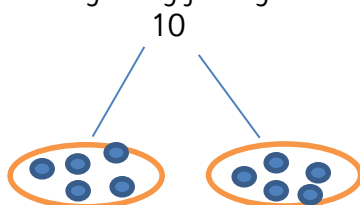
