### **FS1 Happy Home Learning**

### **FS2 Homework**

#### Literacy

Please encourage your child to play the 'Red Word Splat'. Write the red words we have learnt so far on a piece of paper. Say a red word and your child needs to find the red word and splat it with their hand. Whoever find it first gets the point.

Red Words: I the, go, to, my, me, be, he, she, we, said, are.

#### Maths

Please encourage your child to discuss odd and even numbers. We know that even numbers must have pairs of objects. (8 bears can be arranged into 4 lots of pairs) if there is an 'odd one out' (7 bears can be arranged into 3 lots of pairs but 1 odd one out) the number is odd. Please encourage your child to do this at home and record what numbers are odd and what numbers are even in your home learning book.

### **Class 6,7 & 10 Homework**

#### **Reading**

Keep reading your school texts little and often. Remember we aim for seven reads a week – even if it's just for five minutes!

#### **Spellings**

**Y1**-goat boat coat road coach toast What other words can you think of with 'oa goat in a boat' ?

**Y2 Class 6**- We have been working on fractions recognising and making halves and quarters of shapes. Use bread to make some sandwiches. Explain your halving and quartering stories. I started with a whole. I cut it into two/four equal parts. Now I have 2 halves/4 quarters. Ask your child to point to fractions of the whole e.g Can you show me one half? Two halves? Can you show me one quarter, two quarters, three quarters, four quarters?

water, whole, who, wild, would


### Maths
