# NINTENDO SWITCH

**App**  
Nintendo have a smartphone app which you can download to set parental controls on the Nintendo Switch.

**Account**  
To enable the parental controls you must set up a Nintendo Account. It is not possible to set up different parental controls for individual users.

**Games**  
You can monitor which games your child is playing from the app and also how long they play them. You can also access a monthly report.

**Daily Limit**  
Through the app you can set a daily time limit. This will be displayed on the console and show how long they have left to play.

**Restrict Features**  
You can set restrictions such as browsing gameplay, posting screenshots and communicating with others.

**Restriction Levels**  
The levels you can set are:  
Child  
Pre-Teen  
Teen  
These will enable restrictions based on the age of the child.

7 teddies on the bed, one fell off , now there are 6. One less/fewer than 7 is 6.

Y2 Class 6- This week we have looked at one more and one less stories. We have noticed that these number are adjacent on a number line/hundred square. Choose a 'teens' number. You could make it using straws to represent the ten and raisins/buttons to represent the ones. What happens when we add one more or take one away? Can you tell the stories e,g 14 and 1 more is 15 15 is one more than 14 17 and one less is 16 16 is one less than 17.
